"Have you ever read a few pages of a book in a bookstore to see what it's about, then you were into it and before you know it you've read it all in one sitting? **Never-DEAD** by *Ann Greyson* is exactly that kind of book.

It's like every choice Jenna Winter makes leads to the exact moment, a conclusion that leaves a smile on my face and a giddy feeling inside. This surprises me, because **Never-DEAD** begins with action of a plane with zombies aboard crashing right off the bat, and I can't assume that this is going to be a happy ending for sisters Hannah and Jenna.

**Never-DEAD** is just so good, and by good, I mean this one puts me through the wringer, eliciting a range of different emotions - making me angry, happy, and sad enough to cry.
